Exercise equipment includes 3 pulley systems, free weights, total gym, Hoist gym progressive resistance equipment, Bosu ball, body blade, fitter, stationary bike, recumbent bike, rower, upper body ergometer, and treadmill. We also have access to a community pool for aquatic exercise.

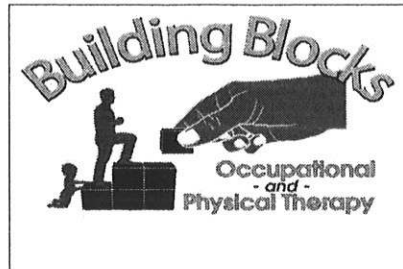
Our patient population is primarily adult orthopedic. We generally see 10% geriatric and 5% pediatric as well. We also have a small population of neurologic out patients.

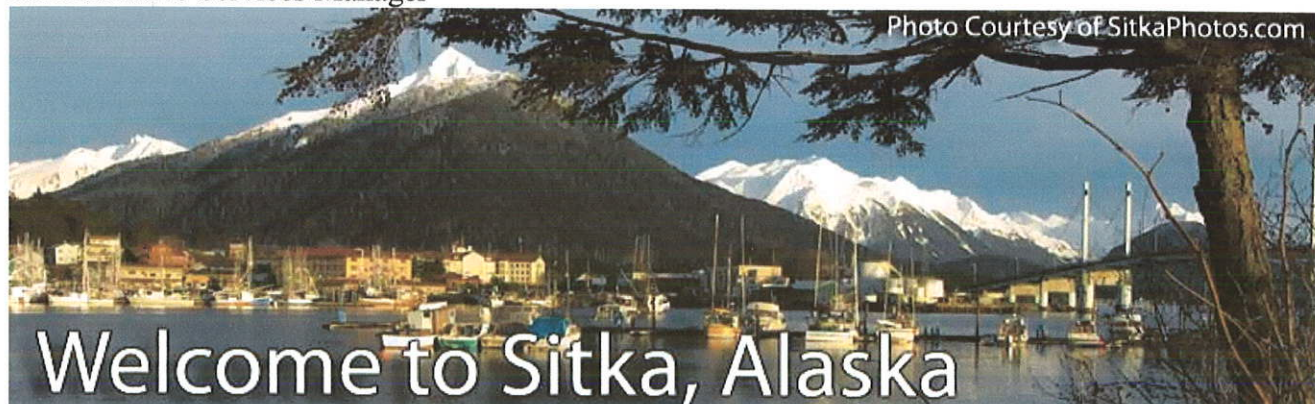
